MAIN AREAS OF ACTIVITY

12. YERYÜZÜ DOKTORI ARI

1. Crisis and Emergency Projects:

Yeryüzü Doktorları provides emergency treatment services by sending volunteer medical teams in the first place in the event of war and crisis situations as well as natural disasters such as earthquake, flood, fire, etc., and supplies medication and equipment. With the understanding of "Life is Better Saving!", in line with the identified needs, it supports repair and operation of damaged hospitals or clinics, establishes field hospitals and clinics, and generates mobile healthcare teams. It develops and implements medium-long term projects so as to replenish the basic needs related to healthcare infrastructure affected by the crisis situation.

2. Maternal and Child Health Projects

Believing that to be born is the most basic right, Yeryüzü Doktorları opens maternal and child health clinics and/or rehabilitates the existing clinics in the regions where birth-associated problems are frequently observed. In these clinics, it provides healthcare services, such as routine antenatal checks and tests for pregnant women, healthy laboring, health checks of nursing mothers, and vaccination of infants. It also provides trainings to pregnant, puerperal and nursing women about baby care and reproductive health.

3. Nutrition Health Projects

Being aware of the fact that it is a matter of life or death, within the scope of nutrition health projects, Yeryüzü Doktorları establishes nutrition health centers and/or supports the existing ones in the regions with frequent hunger problems resulting from drought, poverty, internal disturbances and similar causes. The malnutrition developing especially in children younger than 5 years and in pregnant/nursing mothers due to poor nutrition is treated at these centers. Also, primary health care services and medication support are provided in these centers.

In circumstances where therapeutic nutritional supplements cannot be provided, nutritional support is provided through food packets, meat offered during Eid al-Adha, etc.

4. Retinal Diseases Treatment Projects

Due to preventable or treatable eye diseases cannot be treated because of financial and technical difficulties, thousands of people lose their sight every year. With the aim of lighting the darkness, Yeryüzü Doktorları has treated eye diseases, in particular the cataract, and distributes eyeglasses as part of its eye health activities since 2006.

It also targets to reinforce the local capacity by supporting the healthcare institutions in the regions, where eye health projects are carried out, through capacity-building activities, such as establishment of eye surgery units and training of local healthcare personnel.

Up to date, hundreds of thousands of eye examinations and tens of thousands of surgeries have been conducted in many countries such as Afghanistan, Chechnya (RF), Cameroon, Kenya, DR Congo, Lebanon, Mali, Mauritania, Niger, Pakistan, Somalia, Sudan, Tanzania, Uganda and Yemen.

5. Volunteer Medical Team Projects

Yeryüzü Doktorları provides healthcare services in both surgery and internal medicine branches in the regions in need. For this purpose, it organizes short-term camps in the circumstances where physical facilities are available, but specialist doctors are unavailable and the costs of medication and medical supplies cannot usually be covered. The cases requiring advanced specialty to treat are examined and operated by the volunteer medical teams of Yeryüzü Doktorları. The trainings focused on sharing the knowledge and experience with the local healthcare professionals during such practices are an integral part of the entire service process.

Having organized more than 200 volunteer medical teams, Yeryüzü Doktorları has conducted hundreds of thousands of examinations and tens of thousands of surgeries in nearly 40 countries.



6. Medical Training Projects

One of the problems in healthcare field is the inadequacy of medical trainings, especially in low-income countries. For the purpose of providing sustainable benefit, Yeryüzü Doktorları supports training, certification and specialization programs at associate, undergraduate and graduate levels, and contributes to scientific researches and events by organizing congresses so as to increase the capacity of healthcare professionals in the countries where the projects and programs are carried out.

7. Psychosocial Support Projects

Yeryüzü Doktorları carries out informative and supportive activities for the local community by conducting screening and examinations with the aim of psychosocial support towards the people who have been affected by trauma, disaster and crisis situations. It determines the current status of the local mental health system, and develops psychosocial support projects in line with social needs. It also provides psychosocial assistance activities for the NGO staff and volunteer medical teams serving in the field.

Within this scope, Yeryüzü Doktorları has conducted tens of thousands of psychosocial support sessions and psychological trainings, set up safe children zones. Yeryüzü Doktorları has also held various activities to increase social awareness.



8. Medical Equipment and System Support Projects

Hospitals, medical devices and laboratory tools are among the main necessities to provide a quality health care for patient; however, the biggest shortcomings in economically underdeveloped countries are the lack of health care facilities and inadequate capacity of the existing ones.

Yeryüzü Doktorları supports the provision of mid to long-term, permanent health solutions by establishing or improving medical facilities such as hospitals, health centers, laboratories, blood banks, pharmacies, healthcare units. Within the scope of these projects; the use of local capacities is increased, costs are reduced, and sustainability of healthcare services and employment of the local community are provided.





9. Medication, Consumables and Hygiene Material Support Projects

In underdeveloped countries, there are always medication supply shortages, and there is always a risk of counterfeit medicines in the market. Besides this, lack of hygiene materials during wars and emergencies leads to epidemics such as cholera, diarrhea and so on. Particularly in crises and emergencies, Yeryüzü Doktorları provides medication, consumables and hygiene materials to the regions in need , with the aim of supporting preventive and therapeutical health care services. Medicines or medical equipment donated in-kind or purchased are sent to hospitals, clinics and maternal-child and nutrition health centers.

10. WASH Projects

Epidemics resulting from polluted water and lack of sanitation cause thousands of people to lose their lives every year. Acting with the understanding of "Water for us, life for them!", Yeryüzü Doktorları drills water wells and restores the infrastructures for clean water access in the regions where there is drought and the infrastructure is insufficient so as to prevent the diseases resulting from use of dirty water. It also intervenes in the situations where urgent solutions are needed by distributing water purification tablets. By projects that have been conducted within this scope since 2013, clean water access has been provided for hundreds of thousands of people in Afghanistan, Chad, Kenya, DR Congo, Niger, Somalia and Yemen.







RESOURCE MANAGEMENT

Yeryüzü Doktorları executes its activities substantially with the support of individual donors and has corporate sponsorships and national/international grants as its resources.


To reach to tens of thousands of people in need yearly, field analyses are performed for the resources to be used in an optimal manner. After determining the need correctly, projects and programs are prepared accordingly, and examinations and surgeries are performed. Medicines and hygiene kits are distributed, and water wells are drilled. Moreover, health personnel are trained in order to increase local capacity and necessary equipment are provided to hospitals.

Some of the resources developed are allocated to general administrative expenses and project and resource development activities to ensure the sustainability of the programs.
